

NWG Membership Rules

These Membership Rules apply to all members, gymnasts, parents, carers, and spectators attending the club. Compliance with these rules is a condition of membership.

1. Compliance with Club Rules

- You and the gymnast must comply at all times with these Membership Rules and any additional in-club rules, policies, procedures, or instructions notified by us from time to time.

2. Photography and Recording

- Photography and video recording of gymnasts within the gym are strictly prohibited at all times.

3. Parent & Spectator Conduct

- Parents and carers must remain within the designated parent viewing area and must not enter the gym floor unless expressly authorised by a member of staff.
- Parents and carers must use designated parent facilities only and must not use gymnast-only areas.

4. Toilets & Facilities

- Designated toilet facilities must be used at all times:
 - Gymnast toilets are for gymnasts only.
 - Parent/carer toilets are for parents and carers only.

5. Personal Belongings

- All personal belongings brought to the venue by you or the gymnast are left entirely at your own risk.
- We accept no responsibility for any loss, theft, or damage to personal property.

6. Clothing and Footwear

- Appropriate clothing must be worn during all gymnastics sessions.
 - **Recreational Gymnastics:** Suitable attire includes shorts, jogging bottoms, leggings, T-shirts, vests, or leotards. Hoodies and denim are not permitted.

- **Squad Gymnastics:** Please refer to the Squad Handbook for guidance on required and permitted attire.
- Outdoor footwear must not be worn within the gym at any time.

7. Parking

- Where applicable (depending on venue location), car parking facilities may be made available for use while attending the venue for booked sessions only.
- Vehicles must be parked strictly within designated parking areas and in accordance with any parking rules in place, which may be operated by a third party.
- We accept no responsibility for any parking fines, penalties, loss, theft, or damage relating to vehicles or belongings left within parking areas.
- You are responsible for remaining vigilant regarding any parking monitoring or enforcement systems in operation and for challenging any fines or penalties directly with the relevant third party.

8. Drop-off and Collection

- You are responsible for handing your gymnast over to a coach at the start of each session and collecting them promptly at the end of the session.
- For gymnasts under the age of 16, a parent or responsible adult must remain within the building for the duration of the session.

9. Breach of Rules

- Failure to comply with these Membership Rules may result in warnings, suspension, or termination of membership in accordance with our Booking Terms & Conditions and Refund & Cancellation Policy.
