

NWG Modern Slavery Policy

This Modern Slavery Policy outlines our commitment to preventing modern slavery, human trafficking, forced labour, and exploitation within our organisation and supply chains. This policy aligns with UK legislation including the Modern Slavery Act 2015 and should be read in conjunction with our other club policies.

1. Policy Statement

- We have zero tolerance for modern slavery or human trafficking in any form.
- We are committed to acting ethically and with integrity in all our activities and relationships.
- We expect the same standards from our partners, suppliers, and contractors.

2. Scope

- This policy applies to all staff, coaches, volunteers, contractors, and suppliers.
- It covers all club activities and business relationships.

3. Our Approach

- We seek to work with reputable suppliers and service providers who share our values.
- We will take reasonable steps to ensure our operations are not connected to forced labour, child labour, or human trafficking.
- Any concerns relating to modern slavery will be taken seriously and reviewed appropriately.

4. Reporting Concerns

- Any individual who becomes aware of potential modern slavery concerns in connection with the club should report this to club management.
- Reports will be handled sensitively and in line with appropriate procedures.

5. Monitoring & Review

- This policy will be reviewed periodically to ensure continued compliance with relevant legislation and best practice.
