

Parent's Code of Conduct

We believe that following a code of conduct aids in creating a positive, respectful and supportive environment for all parties involved.

Respect & Support for Coaches & Staff

- We foster positive relationships with the club, coaches, and officials. We trust the expertise of coaches as they guide our children in their gymnastics endeavors.
- We refrain from providing unsolicited coaching or shouting during sessions, allowing the coaches to lead.
- If we would like to speak with a coach, we do so before or after the session, with the understanding that alternative meeting times may be arranged.
- We express serious concerns or complaints through approved channels, following established procedures.
- We do not attempt to contact coaches on their mobile phones or outside of the gym setting.

Commitment to British Gymnastics' & Club's Values & Policies

- We support our child's involvement in gymnastics and encourage their enjoyment of the sport.
- We recognise each child's journey within the sport is unique and provide encouragement and refrain from comparison.
- We are mindful of space in the viewing area to ensure all parents have the opportunity to watch their gymnast.
- We uphold a standard of appropriate language and behavior at all times.

Positive Behaviour & Sportsmanship

- We ensure our gymnast has valid British Gymnastics membership (and therefore benefits from insurance cover) to partake in coach led sessions at Nile Wilson Gymnastics at all times.
- We ensure that our gymnasts have a drink and are appropriately dressed for their sessions, seeking guidance from the Member's Handbook for suitable gym attire.
- Respect for the facility itself is paramount; we maintain tidiness throughout the entire facility.
- Considering the well-being of all, we abstain from smoking and the use of substances within the premises or by the exits and entrances where gymnasts pass.
- If you have any concerns about any gymnasts within our clubs please speak directly to your club Welfare Officer or Operations Lead.

Wellbeing & Safety

- We only enter the gymnasium when asked to do so by a coach.
- We arrive on time and promptly collect our child at the end of each session.
- Until the start of their session, we acknowledge that the responsibility for the gymnast lies with their respective parent or carer. We are responsible for children not participating in sessions for the entire time they are at the gym.
- It is our responsibility to drop off and collect our child from inside the building and notify staff if someone unfamiliar will be picking them up.
- Photography and video recording within the premises require prior permission from a club representative. At competitions and events, adherence to registration procedures is necessary for capturing images.
- We bring drinks with lids to the gym to maintain cleanliness and safety.
- Any observed hazards in or around the building are promptly reported to staff to ensure the safety of all individuals.
